Principles of Design Unbound Book Project

Objective; Students will demonstrate their knowledge of the Principles of Design by creating an unbound book that illustrates each principle of design with their unique stylistic approach.

Criteria:

- 1. Unbound books will contain 8 pages. A cover with title and name, asymmetrical balance, contrast, movement, Emphasis, Unity, rhythm and pattern.
- 2. The title must indicate your stylistic approach and media.
- 3. Each page must be unified. The book should be stylistically the same.
- 4. The minimum page size is 6x6". The maximum size is 6x9"
- 5. Use your absolute best craftsmanship.
- 6. Choose a medium that supports your theme or stylistic approach

Process:

Complete the design questions on a separate sheet of paper

- 1. What size will your book be?
- 2. How will you lay out your book? Sketch an example
- 3. What medium will you use? Why? What is your experience with this medium?
- 4. Explain at least 5 elements of your theme ; color, style, shapes, vintage, retro, pop art, cats,..... Sketch out your idea.
- 5. How many pages will you complete during a class period?
- 6. What materials will you need?
